

The summary file contains all available metrics for household income, personal income, and disposable personal income. The provisional data available is included as well. This is a CSV file, which can be filtered and sorted in excel, or else imported into a statistical program for analysis. Fields which are unavailable for the latest year have a value of “N/A”.

This file contains six fields:

1. **Year:** data year
2. **Ranking:** equivalized income concept which the households are ranked by for the calculation (or “None” for aggregate totals)
3. **Series:** Series in NIPA Table 2.9 which is being distributed (or else number of observations)
4. **NIPA Table 2.9, Line Number:** Line number in NIPA Table 2.9 which is being distributed (or else N/A for number of observations)
5. **Quantile or Summary Metric:** Either an income quantile (i.e., top 5%) or else aggregate total
6. **Value:** Numerical value for the row.

For example, the observation below will match the value for the 0-10% share of compensation in Table 1 (components) of the 2021 single file upload. This observation can be located by filtering **Year** on 2021, **Ranking** on Equivalized Personal Income, **Series** on Compensation and **Quantile** on 0-10%.
