

- Corporate profits
- / Personal income and spending
- / Personal saving



International

Statistics that focus on economic transactions with other countries including measuring the value of U.S. international assets and liabilities and direct investment by multinational enterprises

- / International transactions
- / Trade in goods and services
- / International investment position
- Direct investment by country and industry

Regional

Statistics that look at the geographic distribution of U.S. economic activity and growth, with a consistent framework for analyzing and comparing individual state and local area economies

- / GDP and personal income by state
- / GDP and personal income by county, metro, and other areas
- / Regional price parities by state and metro area
- / Consumer spending by state



Special topics

Statistics for an expanded view that focuses on particular aspects of U.S. economic activity and allows greater flexibility in providing more detailed measures

- / Arts and culture
- / Outdoor recreation
- / Global supply chains
- / Space economy
